# 2025-2026 Florida Resident Game and Furbearer Hunting Season Dates

## Zone A

- Archery season: Aug. 2-31
- Crossbow season: August 2 – September 5
- Muzzleloading gun season: Sept. 6-19
- **Youth deer hunt weekend**: Sept. 13-14 (1)
- General gun season: September 20 – October 19,  
November 22 – January 4

## Zone B

- Archery season: October 18 – November 16
- Crossbow season: October 18 – November 21
- Muzzleloading gun season: November 22 – December 5
- **Youth deer hunt weekend**: Nov. 29-30 (1)
- General gun season: December 6 – February 22

## Zone C

- Archery season: September 13 – October 12
- Crossbow season: September 13 – October 17
- Muzzleloading gun season: Oct. 18-31
- **Youth deer hunt weekend**: Oct. 25-26 (1)
- General gun season: November 1 – January 18

## Zone D

- Archery season: October 25 – November 26
- Crossbow season: October 25 – November 26, Dec. 1-5
- General gun season: Nov. 27-30, December 13 – February 22
- **Youth deer hunt weekend**: Dec. 6-7 (1)
- Muzzleloading gun season: Dec. 6-12, February 23 – March 1
