
This event had 50+ volunteers who provided over 440 hours labor, 13 swamp buggy's, 3 side-by-side, and 2 skid steers loaders.

May is the start of the application process for alligator harvest permits Applying for alligator harvest permits

This year, sustainable hunting opportunities will be offered at 128 AMUs (65 countywide AMUs and 63 specific AMUs). The FWC will be issuing over 7,300 alligator harvest permits through three random drawings and a final leftover phase.

The dates to apply for alligator harvest permits this year are as follows. Remember, all application periods start at 10 a.m. ET on the first day of the application period and run through 11:59 p.m. ET on the final day. MyFWC.com/Alligator



IHEA-USA 2022 Conference

After a 2-year hiatus, due to Covid, the International Hunter Education Association (IHEA) was finally able to have the Conference. FSCA supports IHEA-USA mission to continue the heritage of hunting worldwide by developing safe, responsible, knowledgeable, and involved hunters.

The conference was held at the new Palm Beach County shooting Center. FSCA gave buggy rides and airboat rides in the JW Corbett (WMA) wildlife management area which gave everybody a chance to enjoy the Gladesmen culture. Marshall with Mack's Fish Camp gave airboat ride to exploring the Southern Everglades to learn about its ecology, unique wildlife, and it's "River of Grass" along with our Gladesmen Culture.

Some of the participants took the opportunity to enjoy dinner in the Everglades provided by FSCA members (dinner menu fried Oscar/fish, gator tail, cheese grits, swamp rice, and Gator chowder) following the dinner they went on a Python hunt in the everglades. After dinner before the hunt participants learn to capture snakes safely (Live snake presentation) given by FWC staff members.

The International Hunter Education Association (IHEA) – USA is the professional hunter education association affiliated with the Association of Fish and Wildlife Agencies and the 50-state fish and hunter education programs. The programs employ 55,000 instructors, many of whom are volunteers, that teach hunting and shooting safety and responsibilities throughout the United States.

Hunter Education courses train and certify more than 600,000 students annually. Since 1949, almost 40 million students have completed hunter education courses that cover firearm safety, bowhunting, wildlife management, field care of game, responsible hunting, landowner relations, wildlife identification, and much more.

Hunting is a safe activity, and, because of hunter education, it is even safer! Over the last 50 years hunting related injury rates have decreased dramatically, even as populations of deer, wild turkey, elk, geese, and other species of game have risen to record numbers.

Hunters have raised billions of dollars for wildlife conservation in North America and championed the cause of wildlife restoration programs for many generations. Today, hunters continue to be the most effective political voice supporting legislation to protect wild things and wild places for future generations.



2022 Youth Python Roundup

The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC) along with South Florida Water Management District (SFWM), worked together under the direction of Youth Hunting Program of Florida (YHPF) put another successful Python hunt with volunteers from Florida Sportsmen's Conservation Association (FSCA).

July 29th, 2022 Friday evening started with an educational program given by Ali Courtemanche a member of FWC Python Team with Florida Fish and Wildlife. She explained all aspects of finding and removing Burmese pythons. From how they entered into the Everglades, to where we are with them now. Ending the program with what is being done about removing them to save the Everglades ecosystem.

At dusk python contractors Ozzie Gonzalez, Myron Looker, Matthew Kego, and Matt Briggle loaded everyone into their vehicles that were equipped for hunting python snakes. They were each joined with a youth hunting guide from (YHPF) Billy Boatwright, Steve Stroh, Vic Mortimer, and Jessica Beeagle they all left going in four different directions from there the hunt was on. We were lucky to harvest four snakes between with two participants on Friday evening.

Saturday started off with a early lunch, after everybody fueled up we set out to go fishing, the whole group got to participate parents, guides, and youth, target fish species was Peacock Bass mostly because it's on everybody's bucket list, we were extremely success on our fishing trip we caught oscars cichlids and peacocks along with several other native species everyone had a good time and did not even realize it was 100° outside. This gave everybody a chance to enjoy the Gladesmen culture in the heart of the Everglades, where they visited different locations to learn the Everglades Ecosystem, during the trip every one observed a female alligator on her nest and other wildlife.

The group was back out hunting again Saturday evening another lucky hunter harvest a python which made our total of five snakes for this hunt. The largest snake harvested on this trip was 10'2". the smallest snake was 6'6". Sunday morning we got up and did our paperwork enjoyed breakfast.

Ozzie Gonzalez returned with harvested snakes helped clean and skin the Python snakes from the weekends hunt. We all departure from Everglades Holiday Park where everybody traveled back safely to their home.

We removed these harmful invaders from the wild was another win for the Everglades. Burmese pythons became established in Florida as a result of escaped or released pets. Youth Hunt Program is a great way to teach the next generations to be an ethical Sportsmen who will respect wildlife and to be stewards of the land.

As a Huntmaster myself for the last 18 years, I have to say this was one of the most successful youth hunts that I have seen as a volunteer for Youth Hunting Program of Florida. I would like to thank Florida Sportsmen's Conservation Association, Python Contractors, SFWMD Staff, and FWC Python Management Team for pulling this all together and making it so successful. A total of (5) pythons were harvested in two nights, the largest one was 10'2". Each invasive python eliminated represents hundreds of native Florida wildlife saved. We need to remove pythons from the Everglades and protect this ecosystem for generations to come. We are looking forward to conducting another successful hunt next year.

STA 1 East1





By 9:00 we were heading for the cleaning station where each hunter learned the technique required to harvest a gator.

LOG AND REPORT HARVESTED WILD TURKEY AND DEER

Turkey hunters, a new rule takes effect this fall that requires all hunters (even those exempt from license requirements) to log and report wild turkeys they harvest. This new rule applies to spring and fall wild turkey seasons.

The FWC also wants to remind all **deer hunters** (even those exempt from license requirements) they must log and report harvested deer.

Upon harvesting a deer or wild turkey, all hunters must: a) log their harvest prior to moving it from the point where they located it and b) report it within 24 hours of being harvested.



Hunters can log and report their harvest using the FWC's Fish|Hunt Florida App or at <u>GoOutdoorsFlorida.com</u>. Hunters can also log their harvest using a paper harvest log and report via the phone by calling 888-468-8356 (888-HUNT-FLORIDA).
